Train Warrant Control

Pat Kinney has suggested at the next Fun Run we operate bi-directional using Track Warrant Control. Track Warrant Control (**TWC**) is a verbal authorization system used to authorize trains to occupy Main Tracks outside of Yard Limits.

We would need to finish the passing sidings, put up some mile posts and control point names. Pat would school us on TWC.

Boiler Inspections

I have scheduled a visit with our state boiler inspector Dave Yeager to visit the Mid Michigan Railroad Club for anyone wanting to get their locomotives inspection done. No money is due the day of the inspection, the bill will be mailed to you. Please read through the attached documents so you are aware of what is planned for the testing. These are neither difficult nor complicated. I plan to bring my own hydrostatic pump and anyone is welcome to use it on the test day. There may be other pumps available too. The date of our boiler inspection is set for June 30, 2023, rain or shine (dress appropriately). The inspector is planning to be at the club for the whole [business] day. I plan to bring my locomotive to the railroad the night before and have it setup for the test so I can take only a half day off from work and plan to arrive in the early afternoon. Some others may be there earlier in the morning. Anyone wanting to take additional time to enjoy their locomotives following the testing is welcome to join in the fun. This will have everyone well positioned for participating in the club's run days over the next two days.
